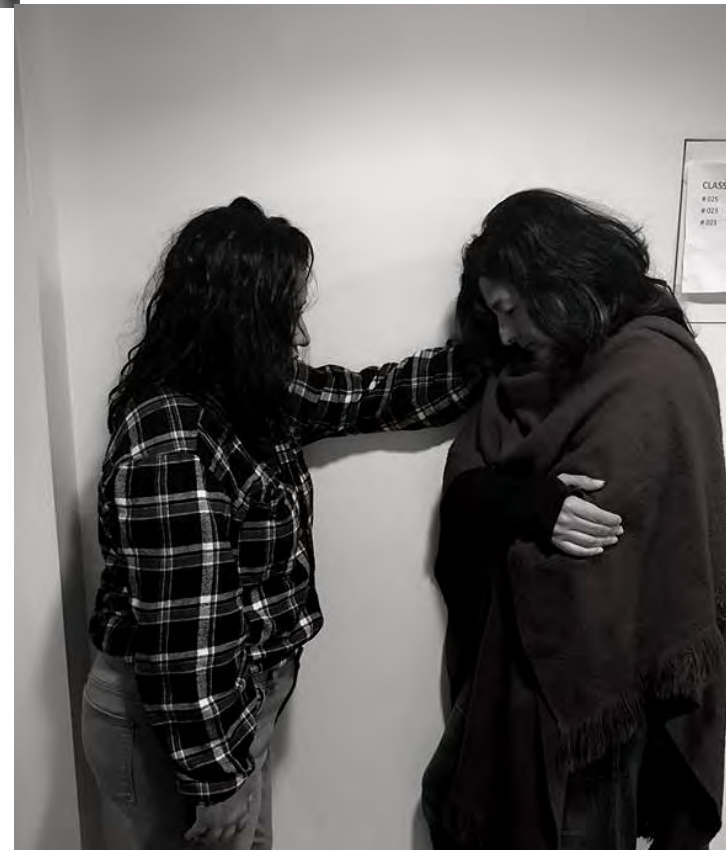






Hi Rosa, you seem kind of quiet today, what's wrong?




Well, I'd just rather be here in the warehouse than alone with Christopher in the orchard.




